## ADULT/YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This event will be a USBC certified tournament for youth and adult bowlers. This is a handicap tournament. Anyone not having a current USBC card must pay a participation fee of \$5 for an adult or \$2 for a youth.
  2. USBC Rule 319d does not apply (Reporting of prize winnings). USBC Rule 319e does not apply (Tournament Rerating rule). All other USBC rules shall apply.
  3. Cost of the tournament: \$25 per team, \$19.65 for bowling, \$4.35 for awards and \$1 for expenses.
  4. Each doubles team will consist of 1 youth and 1 adult. This is a trophy or scholarships tournament. Entrants must choose either Trophy or Scholarship (if won) prior to beginning tournament play.
  5. Age classifications will be based on the youth's age on August 1, 2009.
  6. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the team average and 400. Any team whose average is 400 or over will receive 0 handicap.
  7. All entrants shall use their highest 2008-09 winter league average for 21 games or more or
    - (A) If no 2008-09 winter league average an entrant shall use their highest certified league average as of December 1, 2009 for 21 games or more (verified by a league sheet) or
    - (B) If no December 1, 2009 21-game average, an entrant shall use their highest certified 2009 league average for 9 games or more or
    - (C) If no December 1, 2009 average an entrant shall use their most recent highest certified league average for 21 games or more (including summer league averages) or
    - (D) If no certified league average an entrant will establish an average based on their three games bowled in each squad of this tournament. (The bowler will establish a new average for each squad they bowl in this tournament.)
- Bowlers are responsible for the validity of their own average; whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. If the submitted average is incorrect, the bowler's entering average can be corrected by the Tournament Director prior to bowling.
8. The Tournament Director has the right to re-rate bowlers prior to bowling. Their entry fees will be returned if the bowler does not accept the re-rated average.
  9. Each doubles team will bowl three (3) games.
  10. Multiple participation will be allowed but bowlers may only bowl with the same partner once.
  11. Number of prizes awarded will be based on a 1 to 5 ratio of paid entries.
  12. Any appeal or protest regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to the on-site Tournament Director within 24 hours after the end of the tournament.
  13. There will be no smoking or consumption of alcoholic beverages during the tournament. Electronic devices will not be used during tournament play.
  14. Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting. No hats and no shorts except for walking shorts (knee length) may be worn.
  15. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, or an illegal substance.
  16. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Inappropriate language/gestures during competition or abuse of bowling center equipment may result in disqualification by the Tournament Director.
  17. Squads will be held as listed on the front of this sheet. Check in 30 minutes before each squad.
  18. Pre-paid tournament entries close Sunday, December 20, 2009. Walk-ins will be allowed if lanes are available.
