Spokane County USBC Senior Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will have one division for Singles and one division for Doubles. Men and Women will be combined in a single prize list in each event. **Handicap will be 90% from 230 scratch in Singles and 90% from 460 scratch in Doubles.**
2. **Bowlers may enter Singles or Doubles on any squad.** Doubles entries may be two men, two women or mixed. Multiple entries in Singles or Doubles will be allowed but bowlers must change one member in doubles. An individual can only cash once in the singles event per USBC Rule 315c.
3. Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-11 season. **A 2011 summer league average will be accepted if no 2010-11 certified average is available.** All others bowl scratch.
4. **It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others.** Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
5. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule). **All other USBC rules shall apply.**
6. **The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling.** Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. If the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average, their entry fee shall be refunded.
7. **Bowlers who only have a winter league average in the King Distributing league will have their average rerated upward by 2/3 of the USBC sport league adjustment because of the special lane patterns used for this league.**
8. **Closing date of entries is one half hour before the start of the last scheduled squad.** All entry fees must accompany the entry blank.
9. **Any player arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (USBC Rule 322a).**
10. **Entry Fee: \$20 per individual (\$9.75 for Prize fees; \$8.75 for Bowling fees; and \$1.50 for Expense fees).** There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each event. Trophies will be awarded to the Handicap Champions and Scratch Champions. All monetary prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis. **No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time.**
11. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the secretary within 48 hours after the bowler has bowled.
12. All participants must be members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association do not have to pay local membership dues but must provide verified averages from their association.** Non-USBC members may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership. All participants must be 55 years of age or older on November 12, 2011
13. Changes must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
14. Reservations for spots on the schedule may be made by telephone. **Completed entry forms and entry fees in full for all telephone reservations must be received in the tournament office within seven days or the reservation will be canceled.**
15. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager (see USBC Rule 327c).
16. **\$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.**
