# Spokane County USBC Trio Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will have two divisions. Teams with averages of 570 and over will be in the "A" division and teams with averages of 569 and under will be in the "B" division. **Trio teams may be all men, all women or any mix of men and women. All teams will be combined in a single prize list in each division. Handicaps for both divisions will be 90% from 690 scratch.**
2. Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-2011 season. **A 2011 summer league average will be accepted only if no 2010-11 certified average is available.** All others bowl scratch.
3. **It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others.** Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
4. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule). **All other USBC rules shall apply.**
5. **The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling.** Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. If the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average, their entry fee shall be refunded.
6. **Bowlers who only have a winter league average in the King Distributing league will have their average rerated upward by 2/3 of the USBC sport league adjustment because of the special lane patterns used for this league.**
7. **Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (Rule 322a).**
8. **Handicap Entry Fee: \$60 for Team - (\$9.75 for Prize fees; \$8.75 for Bowling fees; and \$1.50 Expense fees per person). No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time.** There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each division. Trophies will be awarded to the Handicap Champions in each division. All monetary prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
9. An Optional scratch prize list will be offered in this tournament. Bowlers must enter the handicap event to be eligible to enter the optional scratch event. The optional entry fee for each event will be \$10 per person with all fees going to the prize fund. **No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time.** There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in this event. Trophies will be awarded to the Scratch Champions.
10. **Closing date of entries is 30 minutes before the start of the last scheduled squad. All entry fees must accompany the entry blank. Walk in reservations will be accepted up to the start of last squad subject to lane availability.**
11. **Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the team event but must change one bowler on team.**
12. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 48 hours after the bowler or team has bowled.
13. All participants must be members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association do not have to pay local membership dues but must provide verified averages from their association.** Non USBC members may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership.
14. No more than one professional bowler will be allowed to bowl on a team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a current membership card in the Professional Bowlers Association.
15. Changes in line-ups, or substitutions, must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
16. Reservations for spots on the schedule may be made by telephone until November 4, 2011. **Completed entry forms and entry fees in full for all telephone reservations must be received in the tournament office within seven days or the reservation will be canceled.**
17. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager (see USBC Rule #327c).
18. **\$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.**
