Spokane County USBC Open Championship Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will have two divisions. Averages of 190 and over will be in the 'A' division and averages of 189 and under will be in the 'B' division. (Averages for singles over 189, doubles over 379 and teams over 949 will be in the 'A' division. Averages for singles of 189 or less, doubles of 379 or less and teams of 949 or less will be in the 'B' division.) Handicaps for both divisions will be 90% from 230 scratch in singles, 460 scratch in doubles and 1150 scratch in the team event.
2. Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-11 season. If their highest 21 game certified league average as of January 1, 2012 is 10 or more pins above their highest 2010-11 season's average, their highest January 1, 2012 average must be used. If no average last year, use highest certified league average, 21 games or more, as of January 1, 2012 per USBC Rule 319a 1-2. A 2011 summer league average will be accepted only if no 2010-11 yearbook average or January 1, 2012 average is available. All others bowl scratch.
3. **Bowlers who only have a winter league average in the King Distributing league will have their average rerated upward by 2/3 of the USBC sport league adjustment because of the special lane patterns used for this league.**
4. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction by the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher per USBC Rule 319a3.
5. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e 1-2 does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule). All other USBC rules shall apply.
6. The Tournament Manager or an authorized representative may adjust an entrant's average upward prior to bowling. Such adjustment may be appealed to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. If the entrant chooses not to bowl with the adjusted average, their entry fee shall be refunded.
7. Handicap Event Entry Fees: \$100 for Team, \$40 for Doubles and \$20 for Singles. (\$8.50 for Prize fees and \$11.50 for Bowling and Expense fees per person in the team event and \$9.00 for Prize fees and \$11.00 for Bowling and Expenses per person in the D&S events.) No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time. There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each event within each division. Trophies and USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to the Handicap Champions in each event within each division. All monetary prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
8. Optional scratch and handicap All Events will be offered. Handicap All Events will be in two divisions (190 and over and 189 and under). Bowlers may enter the handicap and/or scratch All Events by paying the optional entry fee(s). The All Events entry fee is \$5 with all fees going to the prize fund. There will be at least one prize for each ten entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% within each division. Trophies and USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to the Handicap Champions in each division and to the Scratch Champion.
9. Optional scratch prize lists will be offered in team, doubles and singles. Bowlers must enter the corresponding handicap event to be eligible to enter the optional scratch event. The optional entry fee for each event will be \$10 per person with all fees going to the prize fund. No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned schedule time. There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each event. Trophies and USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to the Scratch Champions in each event.
10. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. (Rule 322a).
11. Closing date of entries is 30 minutes before the start of the last scheduled squad. All entry fees must accompany the entry blank. Walk in reservations will be accepted up to the start of the last squad subject to lane availability.
12. Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the team event and in the singles and doubles events but must change two bowlers in team and one in doubles. The first team event and first singles/doubles event counts in All Events.
13. **Any individual bowling doubles must also bowl singles when they bowl their first doubles event. A singles entry is optional for additional doubles entries.** The doubles event will be bowled before the singles event. An individual can only cash once in the singles event per USBC Rule 315c.
14. All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 48 hours after the bowler or team has bowled.
15. All participants must be members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). Members from another association must pay local membership dues and provide verified averages from their association. Non-USBC members residing within the jurisdiction of the Spokane County USBC association may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership.
16. No more than two professional bowlers will be allowed to bowl on a 5-person team. Not more than one professional bowler will be permitted on a doubles team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a current membership card in the Professional Bowlers Association.
17. Changes in line-ups, or substitutions, must be made at the tournament office as early as possible, but in any event not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
18. Reservations for spots on the schedule may be made until February 3, 2012. Completed entry forms and entry fees in full for all reservations must be received in the tournament office within seven days or the reservation will be canceled.
19. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager (see USBC Rule 327c).
20. **Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting.** No torn jeans, no sweat or pajama pants, no bare midriffs, no hats and no shorts except for walking shorts (knee length) may be worn.
21. \$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.
