Spokane County USBC (SCUSBC) Championship Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** All participants must be female members of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). **Members from another association must pay local membership dues and provide verified averages from their association.** Non-USBC members residing within the jurisdiction of the Spokane County USBC may establish eligibility by purchase of a USBC membership. This tournament will have one division with handicap calculated as 90% of the difference between 210 and the bowler's average. **Handicap will be 90% from 210 scratch in singles, 420 scratch in doubles and 840 scratch in the team event.**
2. **Average:** Entrants shall use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-11 season. If their highest 21 game certified league average as of January 1, 2012 is 10 or more pins above their highest 2010-11 certified average, their highest January 1, 2012 average must be used. If no average last year, an entrant shall use their highest certified league average, 21 games or more, as of January 1, 2012 per USBC Rule 319a 1-2. **A 2011 summer league average will be accepted only if no 2011-12 certified average or January 1, 2012 certified average is available.** All others bowl scratch.
3. **Bowlers who only have a winter league average in the King Distributing league will have their average rerated upward by 2/3 of the USBC sport league adjustment because of the special lane patterns used for this league.**
4. USBC Rule 319d does not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings) USBC Rule 319e(1&2) does not apply. (Average Adjustment rule) All other USBC rules shall apply.
5. **Entry Fees:** \$80 for Team, \$40 for Doubles and \$20 for Singles (\$8.50 for Prize fees and \$11.50 for Bowling and Expenses per person in the team event and \$9.00 for Prize fees and \$11.00 for Bowling and Expenses per person in the D&S events). There will be at least one prize for each five entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each event. All monetary prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
6. **Team/Doubles/Singles:** The Tournament shall consist of a four-woman team event, a doubles event and a singles event. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and total pins with handicap shall decide the winners. Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in the team event and in the singles and doubles events but must change two bowlers in team and one in doubles.
7. **Any individual bowling doubles must also bowl singles when they bowl their first doubles event. A singles entry is optional for additional doubles entries.** The doubles event will be bowled before the singles event. An individual can only cash once in the singles event per USBC Rule 315c.
8. If her partner has not arrived by the time the doubles event starts, and a substitute is not available, she will be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events.
9. **All Events:** Optional scratch and handicap All Events will be offered. Bowlers may enter the handicap and/or scratch All Events by paying the optional entry fee(s). The total of nine games bowled in team, doubles and singles shall determine the all events winners. The first score bowled in each event will be used to determine the All Events winners. The handicap All Events entry fee is \$2 and the scratch All Events entry fee is \$3 with all fees going to the prize fund. There will be at least one prize for each ten entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% within each All Events prize fund.
10. **Grand Duchess:** A Grand Duchess award will be presented to the participant age 70 or over who bowls the highest scratch series in any event of the tournament. **Entrants will be automatically entered in the Grand Duchess event if eligible.**
11. **Substitutes:** The Tournament Official must be advised of substitutes at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time, if possible. In case of emergency after a game has started, a substitute, if one is available, shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count. A substitute shall take the place of the original entrant in the lineup.
12. **General:** In case of a first place tie in ANY event, CO-CHAMPIONS will be declared and trophies given to all champions.
13. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Official before the tournament prize payments are made. The Board of Directors of the SCUSBC shall have power to hear and act on all protests. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Manager within 24 hours.
14. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Official. (See USBC rule 327c).
15. **Schedules and Lane Assignments:** Entries will be scheduled according to date and in order received. The lineup will be the same as shown on the Entry Form.
16. **Check in:** Teams **must** check in one hour prior to bowling, doubles and singles must check in **thirty** (30) minutes prior to bowling.
17. **Entry Deadline:** Reservations will be accepted up to one hour before the start of the last scheduled squad, subject to lane availability. Reservations for spots on the schedule may be made until February 3, 2012. Completed entry forms and entry fees in full for all reservations must be received in the tournament office within seven days or the reservation will be cancelled.
18. **Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting.** No torn jeans, no sweat or pajama pants, no bare midriffs, no hats and no shorts except for walking shorts (knee length) may be worn.
19. \$25 will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc.
